Publicly Traded Securities

Publicly traded securities (stocks) may be directly donated to Galilee Centre and you receive an official income tax receipt while avoiding the payment of capital gains tax. To take advantage of this tax-saving offer, please contact Megan Postin, Executive Director, for further information or talk to your investment advisor. A minimum market value of \$5,000 is suggested.

Restricted and Unrestricted Bequests

"I give and bequeath to Galilee Mission Centre of Arnprior (GMCA) located at 398 John Street North, Arnprior, ON K7S 2P6 the sum of \$_____ (or an accurate description of securities, real estate, or other property given) for it's general charitable purposes (or specify a program)."

Percentage Bequest

"I give and bequeath to Galilee Mission Centre of Arnprior (GMCA) located at 398 John Street North, Arnprior, ON K7S 2P6 for its general charitable purposes an amount equal to _____% of my gross estate, as finally determined for federal estate tax purposes."

Residual Bequest

"All (or _____% of) the residue of my estate, including real and personal property, I give, devise, and bequeath to Galilee Mission Centre of Arnprior (GMCA) located at 398 John Street North, Arnprior, ON K7S 2P6 for its general charitable purposes."

Contingent Bequest

"In the event that any of the above-named beneficiaries should predecease me, or that any of the above bequests shall otherwise not be effective, I give, devise, and bequeath to Galilee Mission Centre of Arnprior (GMCA) located at 398 John Street North, Arnprior, ON K7S 2P6 for its general charitable purposes all property which said beneficiary or beneficiaries would have received if said beneficiary or beneficiaries would have survived me."

Saving/Escape Clause

In the case of a restricted gift it is wise to include a saving or escape clause so that your gift can continue to be useful to GMCA if conditions change in a way that would nullify or make impractical the original purpose of the gift. Consider adding the following language:

"If at some future time, in the judgement of the Board of Directors of GMCA, it is no longer practicable to use the principal of this bequest for the purposes intended, the Board of Directors have the right to use the income or principal for whatever purpose they deem necessary and most closely in accord with the intent described herein."
