Life is tangled! Complex & seldom open to some masterstroke solution. The journey to healing or reconciliation or justice is, as they say, long & winding. Sr. Chittister commends Mary to us as a companion & guide - as one who challenges the urges in us to cut away the knotted places. Who has time to untie a knot when a new rope can be picked up for almost nothing? Who has the patience when so much in life is urgent? Even at the political level there is a deep populist movement offering simplistic solutions to complex & tangled issues. Often so much is discarded & so many are excluded. This is not the way of liberation & not the way of compassion.

Those things that bind us - knots of injustice, knots of addiction or knots that bind our hearts - were formed over time. The lives of those that are pushed to the margins are often tangled in a web of hurts & causes. Liberation and healing is not hurried work.

May we be guided in the Month of Mary to come to know Mary as an advocate for our freedom & for our growth & in a deep way an advocate for the flourishing of compassion & justice.
